Sermon: The God Who Grants Grace
Text: Isaiah 54

Prayer:

- For our church leaders
- For those who are feeling these times in difficult ways: emotionally, financially, spiritually

Sermon Questions and Application:

1. What is something from the passage or the sermon that God used to speak to you?
2. In the sermon, the examples of the biblical prophet Hosea, Hemingway's story of Paco, and the pastor with a rebellious daughter demonstrated an undeserved love shown through forgiveness. Can you tell us of other examples (both biblical and personal) in which you've seen this kind of grace given?
3. VV. 4-10 describe Israel as a wife with a reproach and offense that was grievous to God, and yet God was ready to grant her grace! What are some specific ways in which you have received His undeserved love and grace?

Read this passage along with Romans 8:31-39.

4. What if we truly and consistently believed that we are "the one Jesus loves," and that our God is truly for us?
 - a. How would this impact our daily lives?
 - b. How would this affect how we view and serve God?
 - c. How would affect the temptation to operate in fear?
 - d. How should this affect how we view others?

God truly loves us, and by His grace has forgiven us of our past sins!

Is there an area in your life in which you have not been holding to this truth, and been thinking that you could earn more of His love, or lose it in some way?

Isaiah reminds us: God loves YOU! Jesus' death and resurrection prove it!
