 - b. Our union with Jesus (1 Cor. 15:12-28)
 - c. Our heavenly existence (1 Cor. 15:50)
 - d. Our motivation for holy living (1 Cor. 15:58; 1 John 3:1-3)
- 5. As you think about the next time you get the chance to share the gospel with someone, how will you include the resurrection in that explanation? Prayerfully think it through and maybe even practice with someone.
