- 6. **Drop off** your box contact Brittany (<u>office@brbible.org</u>) for instructions to drop-off your box on the family's front porch




Hi there! As the director of Fusion and a former Loudoun County foster parent, I wanted to give you a couple of snapshots into what life is like for children in foster care! Here are some stats- I'll talk about Fusion in future posts.

- * on average, there are about 60 kids in foster care in Loudoun County
- * the majority of those kids are teenagers who have experienced a life of trauma, but now have a short window to establish healthy relationships before aging out and being on their own
- * children in foster care are surrounded by adults- foster family, their support system, teachers, case workers, lawyers, bio-family, doctores, therapists, judges... people to support them. Right now many of those supports for themselves and their caregivers are limited, at best.

That's why we are doing this book drive and gifting Care Packages to foster care resource families in Loudoun during this time.

How to pack your box:

- Pick a box to use as your container. A shoebox, plastic container, or other cardboard box is fine!
- Details about the foster family you signed up to bless:
 - Family 1 Female (14) She's a tomboy, likes Harry Potter, legos, art, dogs, photography.
 - Family 2 Male (15) Likes skateboarding. Male (9) Likes beyblades, pokemon.
 - o Family 3 Female (15) Male (11), Male (5). No specific likes.
 - Family 4 Male (4) Likes cars and trucks. Female (3) Likes princesses and unicorns. Male (2) Likes construction trucks.
 - o Family 5 Male (19) Likes philosophy and cybersecurity. Male (17) Likes fishing.
 - Family 6 Female (18) Likes music, children, helping, fashion
- Aim for the \$30-\$50 range and fill your box with these or other items you think the foster would enjoy:

Games (Spot It, Speedee Bee, lots of other smallish games with wide appeal)

Books (picture books, easy readers, chapter books)

Arts and crafts

Snacks

Outside toys (bubbles, chalk, jump ropes, frisbee, balls, etc)
