Sermon Questions and Application:

Big Idea: When in a crisis, expect God to work. However, don't limit him to your expectations.

- 1. What is one thing that you remember from this passage or sermon?
- 2. What does the rescue of Moses tell us about the way God carries out his purposes and plans? Do you believe in coincidences? Why or why not?
- 3. All of us at times have felt like God is not working on our behalf, but either ignoring our situation or working against us.
 - a. Consider some of the examples that were given in the sermon of people who would have felt like this too (David in a cave, Esther being selected to be a queen, Jonah being discovered by a whale.) How can knowing their <u>full</u> story help you to endure a situation that might be getting worse rather than better?
 - b. Think of a current role God has you in today. (i.e. Father, mother, employee, church leader, grandparent, etc.) What is a specific way that you are being uncomfortably stretched? Consider Philipians 4:4-9 in addition to Jochabed's faith as a means of finding peace during this uncomfortable time.
- 4. Do you journal the work and activity of God? Consider keeping a journal of your prayers or just a series of events in which God is working. They enable you to build your faith forward as you look back at the surprising ways that God has worked in your life!
